Divisions:

Per USEF rules, Open, Amateur, Junior/Young Rider, and Hors Concours (HC). HC classes do not have the score or video published on competition day, but provide feedback to the rider for educational purposes. We are also offering a Showcase division to have a scored ride with the video published on competition day but not the score. Showcase is a great option to have a video of a sales horse shared on our various outlets online.

Rules:

Participants must abide by all USEF regulations pertaining to tack and equipment. Attire may be formal competition attire or schooling attire. HELMETS and proper footwear are required. Horse leg wraps and/or boots are permitted.

Video Instructions:

Videos should be taken from the letter C if possible but can be from the side, and must not be from a previous USEF competition. They must be published on YouTube as public videos, or unlisted if riding HC. If your ring is not regulation size, please use your best judgement in modifying your movements and our judge will be accommodating 😊 **Please have your videographer use the zoom function!**

Scores:

A score sheet will be sent to each rider electronically with judge's scores and comments. Class results will be posted on the website.

Awards:

Emailed Virtual ribbons will be awarded for First through Sixth place for each division at each level; Halter Ego® e-gift card to First Place. If you ride more than one test at any level, the highest scoring ride will count for awards. Classes may be combined if entries warrant.

High Point Champion Ribbons will be awarded for Training through Fourth Level (combined) for each division. One High Point Champion ribbon will be awarded for FEI, and one for Freestyle. Winners will be contacted for their mailing address. High Point winners will also receive an award provided by Halter Ego®.
